## Changes in prices of consumer market


Consumer price index in January-June 2020 compared to January-June 2019 became 103.0%, including food products, beverage and tobacco products 105,5%, non-food products 101,3%, paid services provided to population 101,0%.

In June of the current year, the consumer price index was 99.7% compared to the previous month, 103.0% compared to June of the previous year.



In June 2020, consumer price index for food products, beverage and tobacco products became 98.5% compared to the previous month, 105.3% compared to June of previous year.





In June of current year compared to the previous month decreasing in prices of fresh fish, nonpasteurized skimmed milk, cottage cheese, corn oil, lemon, banana, cherry, plum, apricot, peach, strawberry, dried fruits, walnut, hazelnut, chestnut, cabbage, cucumber, tomato, pepper, eggplant, green bean, beet, carrot, garlic, onion, fresh mushroom, potato, dried peas, increasing in prices of round rice, buckwheat and semolina, vermicelli, sterilized skimmed milk, condensed milk, yogurt, sour cream, brinza cheese, egg, table margarine, apple, pear, greens, lentil, coffee, cola, fruit juice, vodka were observed. No significant changes were observed in prices of other food products.

In June 2020, consumer price index for non-food products became 100.1% compared to the previous month, 101.5% compared to June of previous year.

In June of current year compared to previous month there was increasing in prices of non-food products such as cotton fabrics, watercolor paints, wallpapers, laminate flooring, hallway furniture, carpets, air conditioners, ventilators, household soap, medical thermometers, decreasing in prices of cut wood, cement, brick, electric irons, TVs, mobile phones were observed. No significant changes were observed in prices of other non-food products.

In June 2020 consumer price index for paid services provided to population became 100.9% compared to the previous month, 101.2% compared to June of previous year. The increase in the index compared to the previous month was due to the increase in the average price of electricity because of the expiration of the limit of preferential electricity consumption applied by the population group for April and May of current year, as well as increase in prices of dental and general blood analysis services.
