
Changes in prices of consumer market

Consumer price index in January-August 2020 compared to January-August 2019 became 102.9%, including food products, beverage and tobacco products 105,3%, non-food products 101,3%, paid services provided to population 101,0%.


In August of the current year, the consumer price index was 99.8% compared to the previous month, 102.8% compared to August of the previous year.



In August 2020, consumer price index for food products, beverage and tobacco products became 99.5% compared to the previous month, 104.9% compared to August of previous year.





In August of current year compared to the previous month more decreasing in prices of food products such as lemon, banana, apple, pear, plum, apricot, watermelon, melon, grape, strawberry, dried fruits, hazelnut, cabbage, tomato, pumpkin, pepper, eggplant, green bean, increasing in prices of round rice, buckwheat and semolina, vermicelli, spaghetti, mutton, sausage products, fresh and frozen fish, sour cream, egg, orange, apricot, kiwi, walnut, cucumber, beet, carrot, garlic, onion, potato, tea, fruit juice, beer and tobacco products were observed. No significant changes were observed in prices of other food products.

In August 2020, consumer price index for non-food products and paid services provided to population became 100.0% compared to the previous month, 101.4% and 101.1% respectively compared to August of previous year.
